### AFTER A DISASTER IF YOU ARE IN YOUR CAR -

**DO** be patient. **DO** slow down. If an earthquake, pull over if shaking starts again.

**DO** turn on the radio for emergency bulletins (such as **KGO** 810, **KCBS** 740, and **KLIV** 1590)

**DO** proceed cautiously (if safe to do so).

**DO** obey "road closed" signs.

**DO** yield to repair and emergency vehicles.

**DO NOT** attempt to cross damaged roads.

**DO NOT** go near downed power lines.

**DO NOT** stop under underpasses or on bridges.

**DO NOT** drive through water.

**DO NOT** abandon your car, except if it is unsafe to stay with it. (If you must abandon it, you should not leave it in a traffic lane. If forced to abandon it in a traffic lane, you should leave your keys in it.)

### AFTER A DISASTER IF YOU ARE AT HOME -

**DO** turn on the radio for emergency bulletins (such as **KGO** 810, **KCBS** 740, and **KLIV** 1590)

**DO** stay at home so that repair and emergency vehicles can travel more easily.

**DO** keep calm!

**DO NOT** drive. Many roads will be closed.
